Dear Christopher,

I'm not really sure what I want to say here. I appreciate what you said in your letter about the complaint, but the problem I have is that I've been through something similar before with Waterford County Council.

When they found out about the symbolic declaration of war I sent to the President, they responded by saying they could no longer be involved — or words to that effect. I have the letter stating that because I went above their heads, and the President's office was now involved, they were stepping back.

I want to be clear that I'm not trying to get anyone in trouble — not in your office, not in Waterford, not anywhere. I just feel like nobody is actually listening to what I'm saying.

How can someone come back to me after a week and say there's a lack of evidence? My father stated in a family law court session that the issues we've had had nothing to do with the sexual abuse I went through. The judge looked directly at me and told me to make a statement or report while giving the order.

Doctors at the Lancara Medical Centre in Bray, specifically Dr. Karen Keogh, told me how blasé my father was when the subject of sexual abuse came up. He flippantly said it "only happened once."

How much more evidence do they want? The State placed me in the care of these people. After 47 years of asking for help, I'm still not receiving it.

I'm waiting on Waterford Lab to get back to me. If there's anything you can do, I'd ask you to please help speed that up. Kind regards,
