Email from solicitor Georgina Phelan

Mr. Condra has complained at having been refused Legal Aid to proceed against persons who allegedly sexually abused him and against a resident in a hostel, who allegedly assaulted him. Mr. Condra was then evicted from the hostel.

Legal Aid was refused to bring proceedings against the hostel and the resident on the basis that Mr. Condra did not have reasonable grounds to proceed. The hostel has wide discretion with regard to the removal of persons from it's premises. The damage suffered by Mr. Condra was limited. He was rehoused and did not offer evidence of serious injury, loss or damage as a result of the alleged assault. Mr. Condra did not appeal his eviction from the hostel. Mr. Condra is not likely to be successful in civil proceedings against the hostel or resident.

Legal Aid had already been refused for the first matter, the subject of the applicant's claim and the applicant had reapplied for legal aid in respect of the same matter. Mr. Condra neither requested a review or an appeal of the refusal of legal aid.

Dear Complaints Officer,

I am writing in response to the email and attached letter from solicitor Georgina Phelan, dated 10 July 2025, regarding my complaints

Your response misrepresents the nature of my complaints and fails to address the real issues I raised — issues which your own solicitors previously acknowledged as serious and actionable.

There are two separate and distinct matters, both directed at the State and its agents, not at any individual:

---

First matter:

The failure of the Irish State to protect me during my childhood

- I was placed into adoption without meaningful oversight.
- · No one from the State checked on my welfare, despite clear risks
- As a result. I was left vulnerable to serious abuse and neglect.
- · When I raised this issue at the Waterford Law Centre, I was explicitly told that I had a massive case against the State and that it would be taken forward.

---

Second matter:

My placement in Maguire House by Waterford County Council.

- I was housed in Maguire House without being warned of the risks posed by other residents, including known sex offenders.
- · I was subsequently assaulted there.
- · After the assault, I explicitly asked for help and was refused.
- · My complaint and claim have always been directed at Waterford County Council for failing in their duty of care not at the individual who assaulted me.
- · When I raised this issue, Ms. Georgina Phelan herself told me, in person, that I had a case against Waterford County Council and that it would be taken forward.

---

At no time have I sought to bring proceedings against my grandfather, or against a hostel resident or other individual. Both of my complaints are about the clear failures of the State and Waterford County Council to protect me — first as a child, and later as an adult placed in an unsafe environment.

I am deeply concerned that your response ignores these facts and dismisses both matters without addressing the serious negligence and breaches of duty involved — despite earlier assurances from the Waterford Law Centre and Ms. Phelan that both cases were viable.

I now request a clear explanation:

- Why have these matters been dismissed after being described to me as a massive case and a clear case respectively?
- On what basis has the Legal Aid Board decided not to proceed, despite your own solicitors' previous advice?
- Why does your letter mischaracterise my complaints and fail to address the real targets of my claims the State and Waterford County Council?

Please treat this as a formal request for review of your decision not to proceed, and I expect a detailed written response addressing each of these points.
